

This lecture will explore the relationship between metaliteracy and multimodal learning to support informed and effective producers of information. Several models for multimodal learning will be examined in relation to the metaliteracy framework. As part of this analysis, specific objectives and learning activities of both multimodality and metaliteracy will be compared to identify similarities and differences. This lecture will illustrate how metaliterate learners strive toward meaning-making by combining modes in such dynamic forms as digital storytelling, virtual worlds, and makerspace communities.




